ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 1 AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON ALL STREETS IN THE TOWN OF LINDEN, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the speed limit on South street between Main Street and Harvey Street is currently 20 miles per hour and the speed limit on all other streets is 30 miles per hour.

WHEREAS, The Town of Linden has determined that for public safety and health reasons the maximum speed limit that should be permitted on all streets should be 25 miles per hour.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Linden, Montgomery County, Indiana, that **Section 51.01** of the Town Code of Linden be amended as follows:

Section 51.01

Section I: Speed limit:

The maximum speed limit for any motor vehicle on all streets in the corporate limits of the Town shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Section II: Sign posting:

Employees of the Town of Linden are hereby authorized and directed to post "25 miles per hour speed limit" and "Children At Play" signs on Town streets.

Section III: Penalties

Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be subject to fines and costs as allowed under I.C. §9-21-5-13.

Section IV: Effective date:

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect 30 days after publication. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
