Town Board President Wade Bennett presented letter from Linden Library to appoint Trina Gaskin to replace Town appointment of Hanna Olin since Hanna has moved from Town limits. Town Board President Wade Bennett stated Town of Linden appoints a member on the Linden Library Board from a letter received with a recommendation and asked if anyone attending tonight is interested in finishing the 2 year term. Town Board Member Paul Buckles stated library needs to follow policy and Trina Gaskin will be fine, public asked how does one get appointed, how many members, what are the term limits? And asked if Mary Broadstreet from the Library Board to discussed further, stated no one has volunteered, currently 6 members, made a call to Trina and she said okay, Town Board President Wade Bennett read letter aloud, this appointment will finish Hanna term August 15, 2023 thru August 15, 2025. Town Board Member Paul Buckles made a motion to accept and sign letter to appoint Trina Gaskin. More public discussion followed with Carla Brady stated she was interested; motion dies from lack of 2<sup>nd</sup>.
