

Linden Town Board Regular Meeting Minutes June 25 2019 @ Town Hall meeting room

Roll Call: Town Board Members Wade Bennett, Paul Buckles and Clerk/Treasurer Janet Heide all present; Town Board Member Andrew Traylor absent

Town of Linden Board meeting called to order by Town Board President Wade Bennett at 7:00pm

Dennis Charleston requested to schedule a car show on May 16 2020; reported this year show had 20 cars and collected over \$500 donated to American Cancer Society, food vendor donated \$100; planning cars at Linden Night Out in September. Board thanked Dennis for all his efforts.

Town Board Member Paul Buckles stated Ed Hopkins asked if Board okay with trimming pine trees east of Wastewater Plant. Board agreed and approves Ed trimming pine trees

Town Board President Wade Bennett requested to hire Adam Hampton costing \$50 each mowing and work with Town Marshal Brian Riehle to mow lawns found to be in violation of ordinance. Town Marshal reported 3 lawns in violation. Board approved

Town Board President Wade Bennett presented and signed Midwest Engineering agreement

Town Board President Wade Bennett presented for signature and read aloud monthly police report

Town resident John King stated confusion of speed signs on South Street. Town Board Member Paul Buckles requested to review and update speed signs in town.

Water Superintendent Earl Heide reported water line repaired at US 231, 514 East Walnut Street and scheduled to repair West Walnut water line leak and Walnut streets will need patched. Board approved

Water Superintendent Earl Heide stated Town will not run out of water if the hog farm is constructed outside of town as heard the petition against hog farms saying. Town resident John King asked if solicitors permit is required for petition signing. Town Board Member Paul Buckles stated no solicitor permit required and hog farm permit will be from IDEM

Wastewater Superintendent Earl Heide reported replacing power panel at wastewater plant since pumps stopped working do to power panel controls

Town Board Member Paul Buckles requested the area west of planned storm water basin be reviewed for addition removal of standing water north of residence homes. Town Board President Wade Bennet will inform Maxwell of additional issue

Utility Clerk Donna Cooper reported calls from residents asking if chickens are allowed in town. Board agreed all calls be referred to Town Marshal

Town Board President Paul Buckles asked how successful was dumpster days. Water Superintendent Earl Heide reported 3 dumpsters filled. Town resident Larry Miller inquired if dumpster will be available this fall. Board agreed to fall dumpster days if funds available.

Clerk/Treasurer Janet Heide presented prior regular monthly meeting minutes for Board approval. Town Board Member Paul Buckles made a motion to accept minutes, Town Board Member President Wade Bennett 2nd motion; Town Board President Wade Bennett called for a vote, motion carries

Clerk/Treasurer Janet Heide submitted voucher register and additional claims for Board approval. Board reviewed. Town Board Member Paul Buckles made a motion to accept voucher register and additional claims. Town Board Member President Wade Bennett 2nd motion; Town Board President Wade Bennett called for a vote, motion carries

Town Board Member Paul Buckles made motion to adjourn, Town Board President Wade Bennett 2nd motion, Town Board President Wade Bennet adjourned meeting 8pm
